CHURCHPEOPLE'S LUNCHEON CLUB, READING

[The Churchmen's Luncheon Club was formed in 1965 under the auspices of St Laurence's Church. Monthly luncheons were held at the Ship Hotel, Duke Street, followed by a speaker (a practising Christian prominent in some sphere) or general discussion. From late 1966 luncheons were held at St Laurence's Hall, and took the form of sandwiches and cheese and biscuits with coffee, squash and wine. Membership was restricted to Christian businessmen and professionals (men only), from all denominations. Women were permitted from 1979, and in 1980 the name was changed to the Churchpeople's Luncheon Club. The club was wound up in January 2000.]
