Each of the three Atlantic cables mentioned (1858, 1865, 1866), others were made in 1869 (French), 1873, 1874, 1880, 1894 (high speed due to large conductor), 1900, 1905, 1910, 1923 (higher speed by further increasing the size of conductor), 1924 (Permalloy tape, 'continuous loading', speed 1500 words per minute, four times that of any other Atlantic cable), 1926, 1928 (Mumetal used and by varying the weight of loading - tapered loading - a further increase up to 10-12 times that of any unloaded cable was achieved).

PASSING OF MR. P. V. HUNTER

The death on 22 Oct. of **Mr. P. V. Hunter**, C.B.E., Hon. M.I.E.E., Fel.Amer.I.E.E., in his 74th year, will be deeply regretted by a very wide circle of friends, for he had been actively associated with the Electrical Industry for over 50 years, serving on numerous councils and institutions. He was deputy chairman of British Insulated Callender's Cables until a few years ago, but had since continued as a director of that concern and subsidiary companies. Born in Norfolk in 1883 and educated at Wisbech Grammar School, he entered Faraday House in January 1900, and on completing his course was awarded an honours diploma. After a year as assistant engineer with the late Robert Hammond, the well-known consulting engineer and electrical pioneer, Mr. Hunter joined the firm of Merz and McLellan at Newcastle-on-Tyne. He stayed for fifteen years and eventually became head of the electrical department, gaining considerable experience of power stations, waste heat generating stations, and railway electrification schemes in South America and Australia. During the latter part of the 1914-1918 war Mr. Hunter was loaned to the Admiralty for service with the Anti-Submarine Division of the Naval Staff, as the engineering member of the committee specially concerned with developing methods of locating and destroying enemy submarines. The other two members were the late Admiral W. W. Fisher and Sir William Bragg, and during the course of their work the now famous "Asdic" gear was evolved. It was in 1919 that Mr. Hunter joined the former Callender's Cable and Construction Co., Ltd., as joint manager and chief engineer. In 1938 he was appointed as a director and, after the formation of B.I.C.C. in 1945 - through the merger of his firm with British Insulated Cables Ltd. - was appointed an executive director and engineer-in-chief, becoming deputy chairman in 1952, and was chairman of many associated companies. He has always been actively concerned in improving methods of transmitting and distributing electricity and to this end he initiated the Callender's Wood Lane Research Laboratories in West London. His constant research and experiments brought him fame as an inventor. He originated the "split conductor" and "four conductor" methods of automatic cable protection, several systems of automatic discrimination for electric power transmission systems and improved forms of transmission cable. During the last war he invented the buoyant cable which defeated the magnetic mine. Mr. Hunter was president of the I.E.E. in 1933/34, and made an Honorary Member in recognition of his outstanding work for both the Industry and the Institution. He was a past-president of the E.I.B.A., chairman of the National Register of Electrical Installation Contractors for 30 years, and chairman of the I.E.E. Wiring Regulations Committee since 1934, apart from serving on committees of the B.S.I., E.R.A., International Electro-Technical Commission and other organisations.
