Administrative/biographical history

Harold Hurley, Howell Morgan and Evan Edward Evans were all employed by Western Welsh Omnibus Company Limited, and were all related. Howell Morgan's mother was the sister of Evan Edward Evans. The actual relationship with Harold Hurley is unclear. All three worked as bus drivers at the Bridgend depot.

The family were descended from the Evans family of Foel Farm, Llangynwyd, and William Hopkin, the lover of the maid of Cefn Ydfa. Howell Morgan, his mother, father and brother are interred in the grave of William Hopkin. Evan Edward Evans is interred in the Foel family grave close by. On the deaths of Howell Morgan and Evan Edward Evans, the family home was left to Harold Hurley.

After working as a bus driver for the Western Welsh Omnibus Company for many years, Harold Hurley left and became an attendance officer with Glamorgan County Council.

Archival history

It was after the decease of the Hurley family that the long service certificates and the log book for Ty Derwen School were found by the new owner, who handed them to the Llynfi Valley Historical Society. The Society transcribed the log book prior to depositing it with the Record Office.
