Administrative/biographical history

David Embleton Harbottle was a mining engineer who went to Hughesovka about 1906. In 1910, he married Sarah Ellen Godber, who had gone to Hughesovka as companion to Mrs Horrox, wife of the Resident Consulting Engineer. In 1914, the Harbottle's moved to Karaganda (in present-day Kazakhstan), where they stayed until 1919.

Archival history

The photograph album and papers were in the possession of Harbottle family. The photograph album was sent to Leeds Russian Archive for copying in December 1991, and copies of the photographs were sent to Glamorgan Record Office by Leeds Russian Archive. Copies of papers were sent to GRO directly by the depositor.
