NHS Trusts are statutory bodies established by and accountable to the Welsh Assembly Government. Pontypridd and Rhondda NHS Trust came into being on 1 April 1999 when the two former trusts – East Glamorgan and Rhondda – were brought together. Trusts provide a range of clinical services, the extent of which is determined by Local Health Boards which are the service commissioners. The great majority of the trust's patients are from the Rhondda and Taff Ely areas and the Trust has developed working arrangements with Rhondda Cynon Taf Local Health Board, to ensure that the local population receives the best possible services

Pontypridd and Rhondda NHS Trust provides a range of acute and community hospital services, including mental health as well as services that are provided in community settings.
