The Band of Hope, a Christian temperance organisation for working-class children, was founded in 1847. Members took a pledge of total abstinence and were taught the 'evils of drink'. Children were enrolled from the age of six and met once a week to listen to lectures and participate in activities. Annual excursion, usually to the seaside were organised for children members.
