Administrative/biographical history

In the 17th century, a county gaol had been established in High Street, Cardiff, run and financed by the county Quarter Sessions. By 1814, the gaol was deemed insufficient and a new gaol was built on land given by Lord Bute in the Spital Field on Whitmore Lane (later called Custom House Street), a site it still occupies today. The new prison opened in 1832, with John Bateman Wood as governor. Henry Green took over as governor in 1868, and was followed by Major John Knox in 1872. In 1876 the prison was enlarged, with accommodation for females and a chapel added. After the Prisons Act 1877, responsibility for the prison was transferred to the Home Office from the county. The prison's capacity was greatly extended in 1996 by the commissioning of three new wings in addition to the three Victorian wings.

The records remained in the custody of the prison until deposit.
