Administrative/Biographical history

The Infants, Boys and Girls Schools were opened in January 1900 and subsequently amalgamated to form Marlborough Road (later Marlborough) Primary School. Separate schools for boys and girls were united in 1943 and many of the pupils were dispersed either to the Infants or neighbouring schools such as Roath Park Junior School and Albany Road Junior School, probably to reduce numbers.

Scope and content

Log-books relate to the daily administration of the Girls School from 1900 to 1943. The admissions register relates only to the Boys School

All records offered have been accepted and listed. The log-books for the Girls School were deposited before 1974. The accessions register was deposited with the records of Roath Park Primary School in April 2004
