Wallington Meals on Wheels, 1956-1958 and Wallington Girl Guides, 1950-1956

Deposited by Mrs N Campbell-Little, May 1984 with Surrey Record Office. Mrs Campbell-Little was Divisional Commissioner for the Wallington Division of Girl Guides (which included Beddington and part of Carshalton) from Dec 1949-Sep 1956. She was also involved in the pioneer Meals on Wheels service run by the Women's Voluntary Service [later WRVS] in the Wallington and Beddington area which included part of Carshalton.

The documents were subsequently transferred to Sutton Archives in 1997.
