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The arrangement of these records reflects the divisions in Methodism prior to the Union of 1932. The majority of the records that have survived are from the Wesleyan Churches, but there are also a few volumes from the Primitive Methodist and United Methodist Churches.

The circuit records are listed first, and then the records of individual churches. The minute books provide a good deal of information on both the business of running a Methodist circuit and its organisation; the Leaders' and Trustees' minutes and account books of individual churches are rich in details of membership, social life and church finance.

The organisation of the Wesleyan circuits has been as follows. During the first half of the nineteenth century two circuits emerged: the Portsmouth (Green Row, later Pembroke Road) Circuit, and the Portsmouth (Wesley) Circuit. In September 1883, the first circuit was split into the Southsea (Victoria Road) and Pembroke Road (Green Row) Circuits. In 1900, the two circuits were re-united into a new Southsea and Pembroke Road Circuit. The Wesleyan Circuit organisation was unaffected by the Union with other branches of Methodism in 1932. In September 1952 the Southsea and Portsmouth Circuits were combined; the Mission Circuit remained separate and comprised the Wesley (Fratton) and Eastney Central Halls, and Queen Street Church, Portsea.

The Portsmouth (Green Row) Circuit included the following churches: Green Row, St Peter's Chapel (Daniel Street, Portsea), Eastney (Highland Street), Chester Road (later Victoria Road), Rivers Street and Grigg Street, the latter superseding the South Street Mission. St Peter's Chapel and Chester Road only remained in the circuit until 1883, and Eastney until 1891.

The Portsmouth (Wesley) Circuit included Wesley (Arundel Street), Buckland, Twyford Avenue, Wingfield Street, Havant, Penhale Road (Central Hall) which joined the Mission Circuit in 1927, Copnor, Drayton and Wymering. After Union in 1932, the Primitive Methodist churches, Ebenezer (Twyford Avenue) and Purbrook, and the United Methodist churches, Stamford Street and Powerscourt Road, joined the circuit.

The Southsea (Victoria Road) Circuit included Victoria Road (formerly Chester Road), St Peter's Chapel (later Queen Street) which in June 1898 became part of the Wesleyan Garrison and Naval Port Mission, Fawcett Road Mission, Clock Street Mission (Portsea), and Albert Road. After the re-union with the Pembroke Road Circuit in 1900, Pembroke Road and Rivers Street joined, but both churches were sold in July 1919. In September 1919 Eastney rejoined the circuit. In 1932, Havant was transferred from the Portsmouth (Wesley) Circuit; the Somers Road, Albert Road, Bedhampton and Emsworth Primitive Methodist churches, and the Brougham Road and Fawcett Road United Methodist churches joined the circuit.

The Primitive Methodist 'offshoot' of Wesleyan Methodism included the Somers Road, Twyford Avenue, Bedhampton, Purbrook, and also Forton Road, Gosport churches, all of which constituted the 'First Circuit'. Albert Road and Emsworth formed the 'Second'.

The Bible Christian 'offshoot' included at first Bethesda (Southsea) and Emmanuel (Landport), and later Grosvenor Street, Brougham Road, Fawcett Road, Stamford Street and Powerscourt Road churches. At first, the denomination called itself the Portsea Mission, but after 1862 the Portsmouth Mission. In 1907 the Bible Christians joined two 'secessions' from Wesleyan Methodism, the Methodist New Connexion and the United Methodist Free Churches, to form the United Methodist Church. There were in Portsmouth, however, no churches belonging to either of the two 'secessions'.
