One toft with a garden adjoining called Goldbeters gardyn containing 3 acres, in Hendon, between the King's highway on the N., the land of John Eston on the W. and S., and the land of Thomas Nychol on the E; also 4 crofts lying together in Hendon, between the land of John Eston and Simon Bunde on the N. and W., and the lane called Moselane on the E., and the lord's land called Harpershotte on the S., which fields are called Upcroft (10 acres), Thyselcroft (6 acres), Goldbeters mede ($4\frac{1}{2}$ acres) and Bernefeld (5 acres).
