HAMMERSMITH DRILLING SQUAD

1914. Two exercise books containing the signatures, (in pencil), from August 16th to October 16th 1914, of the Drilling Squad; the "nominal roll", being the attendance register of the members, with their addresses, and, in some cases, details of the regiments afterwards joined. At end one page from the newspaper the "West London Reporter" December 4, 1914, bearing an advertisement for the West London Volunteers, Hammersmith Company, with which Mr. Travers was associated.

[Mr. Wilfred Travers founded the Hammersmith Drilling Squad on August 14 1914, and it commenced drilling on August 17. It met nightly in the playground of Colet Court, and from it the West London Volunteers of the 1914/18 war originated.]
