The Electrical Association for Women was founded in 1924 as the Women's Electrical Association and renamed the Electrical Association for Women a year later. Its aims were to promote the safe and efficient use of electricity in the home, to express the user's point of view regarding domestic equipment and to help make all the services of electricity readily available to women. The Association went into voluntary liquidation, closing in Dec., 1986, and its records were deposited with the Institution of Electrical Engineers.
