Peel Family Funeral Society records, 1875-1957.

These records were deposited in Walkden District Library. They were transferred to the Archives Centre in August, 1993.

Particulars of the founding and early meeting-place (the "Antelope's Head", Streetgate, Little Hulton) of the Society which was also known as the Peel Family Club, are given in the copies of the rules, 1886 (U17/AB1-2)

Metal tokens of the Society, bearing the denomination "2D" on one side, were given to members of the Society who left early during meetings before refreshments were taken; these tokens could later be exchanged with the landlord of the "Antelope's Head" for refreshments of equal value. A number of these tokens, also deposited in Walkden District Library, were sent to Salford City Museums in August, 1993.
