The following information has been supplied by Councillor E.D.G. Robinson. The West Salford Constituency was created by the Redistribution of Seats Act, 1885, which came into effect with the dissolution of Parliament, 18 November, 1885. There were significant alterations to boundaries on 25 November, 1918 (Representation of the People Act, 1918) and 3 February, 1950 (Representation of the People Act, 1948). The constituency was abolished by Statutory Instrument No.417, 1983, which came into effect on 13 May, 1983. The area of the constituency at that date was divided between the East Salford and Eccles Constituencies. The Constituency Labour Party was formed about 1918. Its final meeting was on 15 March, 1983.
