

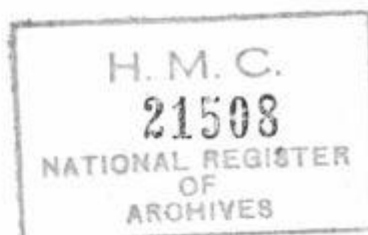

| 3 | <u>Indexed Ledger</u> : showing separate pages for each person, estate or firm, with whom they have dealt and it has columns for date, work done, hours spent and amount owing. | May 1957-Dec 1958 |
| 4 | <u>Letter Book</u> : used as an Indexed Account Book. Showing all the jobs undertaken, material used and the price owed. It has been struck through and dated when paid. | 28th. Aug 1951-

| 21 | <u>Wages Book</u> : showing rate and hours (not filled in), gross amount due, workers contributions, net amount due and employers contributions (not filled in). Loose pages at back of book, which show wages returns on headed account paper sent in, to 5th. Oct 1931 and for 1936 and 1937. | 26th. June 1936-

| 22 | <u>Hourly Record Book</u> : shows an itemised account of each persons job record, with columns for job on which they worked, for whom, hours each day and weekly total.
