The firm of G.L. Michel is first recorded in a Northants directory of 1863/64, as "G.L.Michel - English and Foreign Leather Merchant of 37-40, Newland, Northampton". An 1894 directory shows the premises also occupied by the son of George Leopold Michel as "D. Michel & Co., Shoe Manufacturers". However, by 1903, the firms of father and son had amalgamated to become G.L. Michel & Son, Leather Merchants, at 37, Newland.

The firm carried on several operations within the same premises - leather was bought and sold; secondhand and new boot and shoe machinery was bought, overhauled, repaired or rebuilt, and then resold to shoe manufacturers. Shoe leather cutting knives were made of all sizes and types. Michels firm also went to other companies for the purpose of valuing their machinery. They traded with the firms all over Britain and also France. This trade was established by Michels advertising its rebuilt machinery and knives in most of the leather trade magazines, as well as offering to buy unused or unwanted secondhand machinery from shoe firms, which they could resell.

By the 1920's the firm was run by three brothers, Montague, Henry and Leon Michel, but in october 1929, Leon retired, bankrupt, from the business, due to continued ill health and a series of misfortunes. The firm was continued by the other brothers and one of their sons, David Michel, entered the business later.

In 1972, when the area was redeveloped, the firm left Newland and moved to 1, Purser Road, Northampton, where it remains today, still operating under the same name of G.L. Michel & Sons, Leather Merchants. In October 1983 the firm celebrated its 125th Anniversary.
