Grafog and Fron Farms:

1. 1850 8 Feb. NOTEBOOK belonging to Owen Jones of Grafog, Llandwrog containing notes re temperance, a letter to John Hughes of Grafog (dated 7 March, 1849?) requesting him to sell two loads of manure, and a list of sheep ear-marks for different farms. Also contains a cutting from Y Cymro, 27 February, 1958, condemning government's practice of ear-marking animals for which they grant subsidies as this may spoil farmer's original ear-marking. (Welsh).
