Day and Order Books of the Post Office Betws Garmon otherwise Post Office Salem. The Post Office was also a grocers shop, and was a BG grocers for part of the period of the books at least.

The books record the names and sometimes addresses of the purchasers, details of the items bought and the price paid. Some of the books contain duplicate entries. It appears that the contents of the books were also entered elsewhere. (See also XM/1058/3).
