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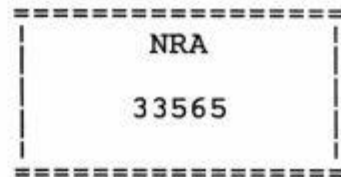

Papers of H. Hughes & Sons, Ltd., ironmongers, Llanerchymedd, formerly T & R. Williams, Dinorben House, collected from the shop in March 1978 before building was demolished. The records consist mainly of shop accounts, but include some papers relating to the North Wales Asylum, Denbigh as Mr. Thomas Williams, one time co-owner of the firm, was a committee member. Mr. Williams was also chairman of the Anglesey County Council from 1905 to 1907. The firm of H. Hughes & Sons, Ltd. still operates in Bulkeley Square, Llangefni and Kingsland Road, Holyhead. They also have very large premises in the Industrial Estate in Llangefni.
